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NEW TYPES OF PROCESSES DIIN AND DTIN – INTERNATIONAL PURCHASES



Introduction

Two new types of processes have been created for International Purchases, which will be linked to some modalities. The difference between them is in the criterion of judgment. They are:

- DIIN - International Non-Integrated Item Exemption- the criterion of judgment can be item by item;
- DTIN - Non-Integrated International Total Exemption - the criterion of judgment is total.

For the vendor there is no change in functionality, the flow is the same.
